Leprosy scratch-off craft

Here is a fun craft to make and use as a storytelling prop. For this craft you will need the template of the man on the following page, construction paper, clear contact paper, white acrylic paint and dish-washing soap. First, print out the picture of the man, and cut it out. Color him and glue him onto a piece of construction paper. Carefully cover the picture with clear contact paper, smoothing as you go to avoid any wrinkles. On a disposable paper plate, mix 2 parts white paint to 1 part clear dish-washing soap. Stir well. Paint white "leprosy" spots all over the man – his face, arms, neck, and legs. Let the paint dry completely. When you are ready, use the picture to tell the Bible story to someone. When you get to the part where the leper is healed by Jesus, use a coin to simply scratch-off the leprosy spots!
